- 1) **Maine SWEAT can provide a pre-feasibility analysis of your building and modern wood heating options** by a qualified engineer at no cost or minor cost share. Pre-feasibility studies evaluate your current heating infrastructure and building heat load, evaluate modern wood heating options, estimate capital and operating costs, and conduct a simple payback analysis to inform your decision making process.
